Smart Heroes Award Ceremony

On the occasion of International Labour Day, SmartLife introduced an inspiring new initiative named Smart Heroes. This program is designed to recognize blue-collar workers who have demonstrated exemplary or outstanding performance in their workplaces over the past year. The highlight of the initiative was the Smart Hero Award Ceremony, which took place on Sunday, 12th May 2024, at the Al Ghurair Accommodation in Muhaisnah, Dubai.

The ceremony was held in association with the Consul General of India in Dubai and the Permanent Committee of Labour Affairs in Dubai. Esteemed guests at the event included H.E. Indian Consul General Satish Kumar Sivan and Abdulla Lashkari, Secretary General of the Permanent Committee for Labour Affairs. Both dignitaries took part in awarding certificates and mementos to the selected Smart Heroes, recognizing their exceptional contributions.

The Smart Heroes Award is part of SmartLife's ongoing efforts to show appreciation for the blue-collar community. This year, SmartLife received over 65 nominations from 20 companies. The award criteria encompassed various aspects of worker performance, including adherence to safety protocols, participation in community service, prevention of accidents or emergencies, and special acts that go above and beyond the call of duty (ABCD). From these nominations, a jury selected 13 winners for the Smart Heroes Award 2024.

In addition to the award presentations, the event featured an entertainment program, making the celebration both memorable and enjoyable for all attendees.

SmartReading

May 2024 saw the completion of the H1 2024 intake where 135 students qualified and appeared for their exams after completing their courses. The dedication and hard work of these individuals, throughout the year, have been truly inspiring.

SmartReading offered courses across four levels: Beginner, Junior, Senior, and Advanced. Each level was tailored to meet the specific needs and abilities of our students, ensuring that everyone had the opportunity to improve their English reading skills at a comfortable pace. The program saw active participation from 14 companies, whose support has been invaluable in making this initiative a success. These companies actively encouraged their employees to take part, thereby promoting a culture of continuous learning and development.

SmartReading celebrated the achievements of 19 toppers who excelled in their respective levels. Additionally, many students were recognized for their maximum attendance, demonstrating their commitment and perseverance.

Similar to the SmartReading program, SmartComputer has also concluded with an exam. All our students have demonstrated their abilities after more than five months of learning.









SmartWoman

In May, SmartWoman organized three consecutive sessions focused on health and safety for women.

The first session, a Deep Breathing and Group Meditation event, was held at the Transguard women's camp in Jebel Ali in collaboration with Power Of Purity Group. It introduced nearly 25 attendees, many of whom were new to meditation, to the process of deep relaxation.

The second session, a 90-minute workshop on Stress Relief through Breathing, Meditation, and Simple Stretching Exercises, took place at Al Ghurair Facilities Solutions ladies camp. Organized by SmartWoman in association with the Rotary Club, Nisrine Douma led the session. She taught various stress-relieving techniques that participants could practice daily. The ladies learned about the benefits of breathing and meditation, including stress and anxiety reduction, improved sleep, and maintaining positivity in difficult situations. Nisrine also conducted a Q&A session to address the concerns of the blue-collar attendees.

The third session, SmartWoman also organized an interactive session on self-defense techniques in collaboration with Rotaract Dubai at Emrill Services. This session was aimed at equipping women with essential skills for self-protection. The participants had a wonderful learning experience, gaining practical knowledge and confidence to ensure their personal safety.

SmartWoman launched the Crochet Project for the Al Ghurair Facilities residents in Sonapur. This project aims to empower blue-collar women by providing them with crochet kits and teaching them the basics of crochet. Crochet is not just a craft; it is a means of enhancing financial independence and stability. By developing these skills, we hope to enable these women to become self-reliant and create brighter futures for themselves and their families.
