A comprehensive and wide-reaching campaign was organized in major parts of the city and its outskirts to educate undocumented residents about legalizing their status, extending their stay or returning to their home country.

As part of the campaign, Lawyer Mahadevan, the former president of the Rotary Club of Downtown and dedicated patron of SmartLife, participated in an enlightening interview on Radio FM 89.4, addressing questions from the community and raising awareness on the Amnesty program. Moreover, in partnership with SmartJobs, SmartSupport effectively identified corporations who were eager to provide job opportnities to qualified candidates committed to remaining in the UAE. Lastly, SmartLife held close and fruitful dicussions with Mr. Abdullah Lashkari, the Secretary General of PCLA, on planned activities of the Amnesty program for the next two months.

Fully equipped with the necessary approvals, SmartSupport is poised to support both the worker community and the government in the Amnesty initiative over the upcoming months.
